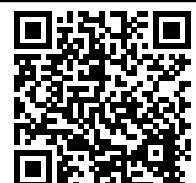
Description

Large Oil on Canvas showing poplars blowing in the wind on the edge of the Meuse river. The painting is signed by the artist Louis Cambier (1874 - 1957). The painting is mounted in a stunning silver gilt frame. There is some small damage to the frame which is barely visible. Cambier Louis Gustave was a pupil of the orientalist painter Jean François Portaels, who was Director of the Academy of Brussels. Cambier's early years were concentrated on his activity within the Brussels Artistic Circle. He was a great traveler and visited France (Paris and Brittany), Italy, Palestine, Turkey, Asia Minor. As Camille Lemonnier writes "Cambier brings back rough and severe landscapes from the Holy Land". It is a severity influenced by the "Nabi" synthesis and colored by Matisse's Fauvism (which portrays him in a drawing) with which he works after moving to Paris. In the French capital he attended courses at the Académie Ranson, perfecting his style. He exhibited at the Salon des Artistes Français of which he became a partner, obtaining an honorable mention in 1906. During the First World War he lived in Cagnes where he met Renoir and Signac. For a few years he adhered to French...

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
