The stones are claw-set within a unfussy 18k yellow gold half-hoop setting, confirming to a slender yellow gold shank. Accompanied by an independent jewellery report from IGR. Cut: Old mine cuts. Colour: The centre is H. The remaining diamonds are H to I. Clarity: The centre is VS2. The remaining diamonds range from VS2 to SI2. Carat: The centre is approximately 0.35 carat, with a total approximate diamond weight of 1.09 carat. Circa: 1900. Size: R (UK) or 8 5/8 (US). Free sizing available. Measurements: From the edge of one outer diamond to the other is 15.6mm. The ring is 4.6mm at the widest point and sits 3.7mm from the finger. Weight: 2.39 grams. Metal: 18k gold. Tested with a Niton DXL Precious Metal Analyzer.
