A particularly rare and desirable detail is the integrated brushing slide, positioned above the top drawer. Originally used for garment preparation or writing, it remains both functional and evocative of the chest's refined Georgian origins. The piece stands proudly on its original ogee bracket feet and retains its original brass handles and escutcheons, now mellowed with age to a soft verdigris hue. Minor, sympathetic restorations have preserved its structure and surface without compromising authenticity. A collector's piece of genuine distinction, this chest represents the perfect blend of historical integrity and decorative sophistication, making it an ideal addition to both heritage collections and elegant contemporary interi...
