The family firm was reportedly founded in 1810 by Joseph Mappin, and their sun trademark was granted in 1835 by the Cutlers' Company. They were not known as Mappin Brothers until after 1852 when all four of Joseph Mappin's sons had joined the company, after his death. It was a year earlier in 1851 that they opened the Queen's Plate and Cutlery Works on Baker's Hill, bound by Little Pond Street and Flat Street. In 1859 there was an argument between the brothers and both the eldest son, Frederick, and the youngest, John, left the company. Frederick Mappin became a politician and was a director of m...

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
