It is hallmarked for Birmingham, 1894 and the maker Henry Manton. It is in very good condition for its age. The silver is in good condition. There are no cracks or major damages to the glass just some minor small surface nibbles. It has been cleaned and the silver gently polished and overall it displays very well.
