Description

An extremely rare glass inkwell in the Art Pottery or Art Nouveau style, made in Bohemia either by the famed Loetz factory or their main rival, Wilhelm Kralik. Of a well-balanced design, the rich and vibrant iridescent metallic glass has an organic web of pulled glass trailing. The cast brass collar and lid are well-patinated, the latter having an engraved stylized lotus design. The original clear glass ink container is in position. The inside of the lid bears makers or registration marks: "O.E.P. 10385/ R.G.M. ????" (see photos). Excellent original condition (slight chips to the top of the ink reservoir).
