A Burmese sapphire that absolutely takes our breath away. The electric, otherworldly stone - certified as natural, unheated, and originating from Burma (Myanmar) is a rich, deep and glowing blue. Twelve old mine cut diamonds of graduating size encircle the sapphire, with ornate detailing in the under-gallery leading to a slender 18k white gold shank. Accompanied by a report from Gemmological Certification Services (GCS) stating the sapphire shows no indication of heating, and is Burmese (Myanmar) in origin. Cut: The sapphire is oval cut. The diamonds are old mine cuts. Colour: The diamonds range from H to I. Clarity: The diamonds range from VS2 to SI2. All are clean to the naked eye. Carat: The sapphire is 2.30 carat, with a total approximate diamond weight of 0.66 carat. Circa: 1950. Size: K 1/2 (UK) or 5 3/8 (US). Free sizing available. Measurements: The sapphire is approximately 8.9 x 6.7mm. The head of the ring is 16 x 12.2mm and sits 6mm from the finger. Weight: 3.77 grams. Metal: 18k white gold.
