In very good condition Cleaned and lined with some minor stable craquelure Frame good condition with only a few minor losses which have been gilded over John Callow (1822-1878) John Callow was taught by his brother, the artist William Callow. He became a member of the New Watercolour Society, and an associate of the Old Watercolour Society. He was junior professor of drawing at the Royal Military College, Addiscombe from 1855 to 1861. He was master of landscape at the Royal Military Academy, Woolwich, 1861-5 and professor at Queen's College, London, 1875-8. He painted marine subjects and landscapes.
