Description

This grand and fine example of ROGERS BLUE AND WHITE TRANSFER WARE dates from circa 1830. This FOOT BATH, of bold, confident design, was made by JOHN ROGERS & SON (1815-1842) of DALE HALL, LONGPORT, STAFFORDSHIRE POTTERIES. The base bears their impressed name and the name of the pattern 'ATHENS'. Set within a border of flowers and scrolls, the crisp, clear transfer print shows Classical Ruins in a pastoral scene. The FOOT BATH has a generous, bulbous belly, shaped rim and strong, ornate handles. There is obvious damage. There are old chips to the edge, star cracks to the base and a horizontal crack to the side. The handles are undamaged and the whole is in a stable condition and can be handled confidently. There is no restoration. If the Foot Bath is to be used for holding flowers or plants I would recommend a liner is used. A beautiful piece which displays magnificently.
