Likely drawn from the east end looking west through the ruined Gothic choir. This drawing captures the sweeping tracery arches and columned walls typical of Cistercian architecture, with creeping ivy and softened edges emphasizing the passage of time. This style is strongly linked to the Romantic topographical tradition of the early-to-mid 19th century, reminiscent of works by Henry Gastineau or Frederick Mackenzie, whose art focused on the grandeur of Britain's ecclesiastical ruins.
