Description

A very pretty table timepiece by this good maker. The circular, 8 day duration, chain fusee timepiece movement with Anchor Recoil escapement. The back plate bearing the maker's name "JUMP. LONDON". Also having a pendulum transit lock and a shaped bob with top-mounted micrometer regulation adjustment. Behind only a 4" diameter, bowed painted dial that is nicely set within a circular brass frame. The dial has outer Arabic 5's, a divided minute ring and inner, Roman hour numerals. It is also signed "Jump" (of) "London". The matching steel hands are of split arrowhead style and the dial is protected with a cast brass bezel with a snapped-in bowed glass. This is released with a side push button. Contained in a figured mahogany 'balloon' style waisted case. The front edge has a border of inlaid cross grain satinwood that is within ebony and boxwood stringing. The waisted centre has an inlaid floral paterae and the straight plinth has a moulded top edge and stands upon 4 cast brass, 'lions paw' feet. * Joseph Jump was apprenticed to none other than Benjamin Lewis Vulliamy in c.1827. When Benjamin died Joseph and his brother actually took over the business and succeeded him....

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
