Type of artwork: Original Watercolour – “Ruins in a Landscape” Surface: Watercolour Paper Artist and Signature: Attributed to William Payne OWS (1760–1830), unsigned Landscape Study: This evocative watercolour captures a romanticised ruin set in a richly atmospheric landscape. Two period figures stroll through the archway of a twin-towered gatehouse, surrounded by wooded paths and subtle evening light. With delicate brushwork and expert tonal handling, the painting strongly echoes the style of William Payne – a pioneering English watercolourist and founding member of the Old Watercolour Society, known for integrating architectural ruins into poetic natural settings. Approximate age of artwork: Circa late 18th to early 19th century (c.1790–1820) Is the artwork Framed or Mounted: Framed, as shown. Important notice regarding frames – please read carefully.
