A classy late Art Deco sapphire and diamond cluster ring. The emerald-cut sapphire in the centre - certified as natural and unheated - displays a deep greenish blue and is rubover set in milgrained platinum. The stone 'floats' within a surround of 16 eight-cut diamonds. Fine geometric detailing in the gallery leads to a slim and flat 18k white gold shank. Accompanied by a sapphire report from Gemmological Certification Services (GCS) stating the sapphire shows no indication of heating. Cut: Emerald cut sapphire and eight-cut diamonds. Colour: The diamonds are F to G. Clarity: The sapphire is loupe clean. The diamonds range from VS1 to VS2. Carat: The sapphire is a known 2.20 carat. With a total approximate diamond weight of 0.48 carat. Circa: 1940. Size: Q (UK) or 8 (US). Free sizing available. Measurements: The sapphire is 8.00 x 6.09mm. The head of the ring is 13.7 x 11.25mm and sits 5mm from the finger. Weight: 2.43 grams. Metal: 18k white gold and platinum. French hallmarks. Item # 213413S134
