Albert Guillaume was the son of the architect Edmond Guillaume and brother of Henri Guillaume (also an architect). He was a pupil of Jean Léon Gérôme and exhibited in Paris with the Société Nationale des Beaux-Arts, the Salon des Artistes Français and the Salon des Humoristes. He was awarded a bronze medal at the Exposition Universelle of 1900. Guillaume illustrated a number of works by Willy ...
