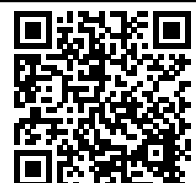
Description

Utterly magnificent. This glorious antique solitaire ring features a cushion cut sapphire - certified as natural, unheated and originating from Ceylon (Sri Lanka) - which displays a subtle colour change: blue in daylight; purple in incandescent light. The stone is secured by four platinum double claws with beautifully intricate detailing in the gallery. Leading to a slender platinum shank set with 8 (four each side) eight-cut diamonds in the milgrained shoulders. Accompanied by a report from Gemmological Certification Services (GCS) stating the sapphire shows no indication of heating, and is Sri Lankan (Ceylon) in origin. Cut: Cushion cut sapphire and eight-cut diamonds. Colour: The diamonds are H to I. Clarity: The sapphire is eye-clean. The diamonds are SI1 to I1; all are eye-clean. Carat: The sapphire is 4.09 carat. With approximately 0.08 carat of diamonds in the shoulders. Circa: 1910. Size: M 1/2 (UK) or 6 1/4 (US). Free sizing available. Measurements: The sapphire is 8.0 x 9.2mm. And sits 6.2mm from the finger. Weight: 4.07 grams. Metal: Platinum. Tested with a Niton DXL Precious Metal Analyzer. Item # 213413S161
