Bears the makers mark for Edinburgh barometer maker Thomas Dunn, working at this address from 1843 to 1863. Presented in superb original condition, fully serviced and working. Keep up to date via Instagram - sturmansantiques. Measures 34" long x 2" wide at the trunk and 4" maximum width at the cistern cover x 1" deep at trunk and 3" deep at cistern cover.
