They are of baluster squat form with flared necks and painted with still lifes of fruit within gilt borders, shape numbers F1110 and signed with printed puce factory marks to the base. Dimensions in cm: Height 10 cm x Width 8.5 cm x Depth 8.5 cm Dimensions in inches: Height 4 inches x Width 3 inches x Depth 3 inches Royal Worcester is believed to be the oldest and second oldest remaining English porcelain brand still in existence today (disputed by Royal Crown Derby 1750 year of establishment). It all started with Dr John Wall, a physician, and William Davis, an apothecary, who developed a unique method for producing porcelain and, in 1751, persuaded a group of 13 businessmen to invest in a new factory at Warmstry House, Worcester, England, on the banks of the River Severn. Dr Wall secured the sum of £4500 from the partners to establish the factory, known then as "The Worcester Tonquin Manu...
