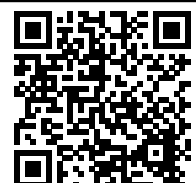

James Cartland and Sons was founded 1823 as Dyer and Cartland in Loveday St., Birmingham and were renowned for their many registered designs, craftsmanship and quality.
