In fact it is almost the perfect size to complement a much larger, but similar, example on a big piece of wall space, or in the same room to continue a style, but also it is a great size to make a feature of by itself in a smaller room or wall space. The surface and patina is good and it is a really attractive piece indeed. The gilding also remains in relatively good condition and has a lovely old lustre to it. The actual mirror plate itself has been replaced at some point in the not to distant past, which of course makes it functional and its nice that when replaced previously the owner went to the trouble of putting a nicely bevelled piece of glass in place. There are a few minor old breaks and repairs to the frame, but certainly nothing of consequence or concern and these are all historic, having been well repaired. As with all our objects thi...
