The body of the vessel with superbly detailed embossed engraving depicting a pheasant shoot, man with gun in the trees and a dog chasing a fleeing pheasant. Complementing engraved decoration to the stepped foot. Bears the makers mark for Exeter silversmith William Parry along with clear hallmarks.
