The case and the scissors are both clearly hallmarked for Birmingham, 1906 and the maker Lawrence Emanuel. The scissors are in good condition for their age. There are some small areas of rust and corrosion on the blades but they open and close smoothly. There are some light surface marks and a couple of small dents and dinks in the case but overall it displays well.
