Description

A fantastic oil on artist board by the highly regarded artist Sir David Murray RA 1849-1933. A superb work that depicts an extensive highland landscape probably on the coast. In the distance can be seen boats hauled onto the beach and in the foreground a man struggles under the weight of his load of bracken or sticks, as his dog waits patiently in front for him to catch up. The work is most likely a study painted plein air and the technique uses thick impasto paint in an impressionist manner. The use of colour is wonderful with a really bright and light feel. The painting is in excellent condition and is signed to the lower right. Sir David Murray RA 1849-1933 was a highly important Scottish landscape painter often compared to Turner. He was the son of a shoemaker and worked for eleven years for two mercantile firms. He managed to work and study in the evenings at the Glasgow School of Art under Robert Greenlees. He was finally able to devote himself full-time to an artistic career from about 1875. He became an Associate of the Royal Scottish Academy in 1881, and moved to London in 1882 where he was an immediate success. His 'My Love has gone a-Sailing' exhibited in 1884...
