An awesome vintage sapphire and diamond cluster ring. The cushion cut sapphire in the centre is a bright and zinging electric blue, and is secured within a surround of ten deep and chunky old mine cut diamonds in platinum coronet settings. A further two diamonds are set in platinum at the top of the shoulders, leading to a slim 18k rose gold shank. The engraving in the gallery just below the diamonds - a detail that almost no one will ever see - demonstrates the care and craft that went into making this truly special ring. Accompanied by an independent jewellery report from IGR. Cut: Cushion cut sapphire and old mine cut diamonds. Colour: The diamonds range from G to I. Clarity: The sapphire is eye-clean. The diamond range from VS1 to VS2. Carat: The sapphire is approximately 4.49 carat, with a total approximate diamond weight of 2.76 carat. Circa: 1935. Size: P 1/2 (UK) or 7.75 (US).
