A fine pair of Nantgarw porcelain plates, circa 1818-22. Each plate finely potted with shell-moulded rims with twelve equal lobes, the cavetto very finely painted in London, probably by the Bradley workshop, with full floral sprays, including two superbly painted roses, chrysanthemums, bluebell and morning glory, within a blue enamel line in Sèvres style and surrounded by scattered insects, the borders with five smaller sprays and dentil gilt rim, two further insects on the underside of one, 23.2cm diam, impressed NANT-GARW CW For a similar pair of plates sold by Bonhams on 05 December 2007, see lot 517: <https://www.bonhams.com/auction/15273/lot/517/a-good-pair-of-nantgarw-plates-circa-1818-20/> Condition: Excellent with no damage or restoration.
