Turn golden oak case with carved geometric petal design decoration. Engraved silvered dial with weather predictions and geometric decoration to the centre; crescent thermometer set to the base and aneroid movement sat behind. Quarter plate bevelled edge with central reading marker sat over the top mounted in a polished brass bezel. Bears the makers name for London barometer makers Newton & Co, Fleet St - barometer makers to Queen Victoria. Fredrick Newton is recorded as making barometers from 1858 to 1900.
