## Description

The mirror has a cushion-moulded frame, a hallmark of the period, distinguished by its bold, projecting profile and architectural quality. The outer edge of the frame and the glass is bordered by ebonised edging, providing a striking contrast to the walnut and lending the piece a sense of refined drama and depth. This mirror likely retains its original or period mirror plate, with the charming signs of age including light foxing and a soft reflective surface that speaks to centuries of history. The back is panelled. Elegant and timeless, this mirror exemplifies the rich decorative aesthetic of the William and Mary period and would make a stunning focal point in any interior.
