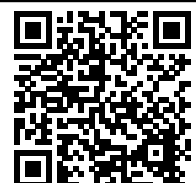

A further six (three each side) diamonds are set in the platinum shoulders. Accompanied by an independent jewellery report from IGR. Cut:? Old European cuts. Colour:? The two main diamonds are I and K. The two accent diamonds are H and I. The diamonds in the shoulder range from G to H. Clarity:? The four main diamonds range from VS1 to VS2. The diamonds in the shoulders are SI1. Carat:? Each of the diamond main diamonds is approximately 1.00 carat.
