Description

A rare Chelsea porcelain bust of Spring, c. 1755. Modelled as the bust of a Classical Goddess, with separately modelled garland of flowers in her hair. Set upon a high pedestal architectural base, the moulding with gilt detail. Red anchor mark to the reverse. For a set of 'bustos of heathen gods and goddesses' see, 'F. Severne Mackenna, Chelsea Porcelain The Red Anchor Wares (1951), pl 54, fig 108. Height - 10.2 cm, 4". Width - 3.7 cm, 1 1/2". Depth - 3.7 cm, 1 1/2". Condition - Head re attached, chip to nose, bust re attached to base. Chips to base and floral garland - please see images for detail. I personally prefer to see a rare piece of antique porcelain in its aged condition, and this example still displays well. Even so, if it is your preference, the bust can be restored.
