The richly figured mahogany top with a rosewood crossbanded edge and D-end drop flaps, with typical beading to the sunken drawer panels and unusually with an opening drawer and a faux drawer to each side, raised on a turned column with beaded moulding on a concave platform base with hipped reeded sabre/cabriole legs and brass caps and castors. He followed in his father, Thomas Trotter's footsteps, to become a member of The Merchant Company in 1797 and by 1805 he took over the firm Young & Trotter where he had been junior partner. Accounts from the firm survive for over fifty patrons including Marquesses, Earls, Lords and Baronets. Often regarded as the greatest and most eminent of all Scottish cabinet makers, his success was in part due...
