This fine table of diminutive proportions features a solid, well figured mahogany top. Supported by eight fine ring turned supports, two of which swing out to support the drop-leaves. This attractive, petit, high quality table is extremely functional and multi-purpose. Is in good condition and ready for use. Dimensions: This table measures approximately 62.5 cm (24.5") tall, 84.75 cm (33.75") wide leaves up, 31 cm (12.25") wide leaves down, and 80 cm (30.5") deep. Condition: Please see the pictures for details of the items condition. - This table is in good condition, commensurate with its age, and is structurally sound and sturdy. Some minor marks and blemishes. No loose joints. No obvious signs of damage or repairs. Good colour, patina and wax polish finish.
