The long drawers are graduated and all open and close smoothly with brass bail handles on Chippendale design backplates with matching escutcheons, old brass locks but no key. . The drawers are oak lined with very fine boards of wainscot oak, solid and robust with beautifully cut dovetails. . The colour of the walnut is rich and warm and vibrant with a lovely grain and natural deep patination. . The chest stands at around chest height and is well proportioned. All set on tall bracket feet. . An attractive George II period chest on chest of an unusually small and desirable size. . . Dimensions are: . 38 inches wide (max), 52.5 inches high and 19.5 inches deep. . Top case lifts off at 27 inches from the floor. . For metric please multiply by 2.5
