An Unusual Large Wrought Iron Staircase and Features

Description

This is a very unusual Art Nouveau Period Staircase with other features apparently originally purchased as part of the Station building at Hungerford in Berkshire, probably the original staircase and balcony when the station became a permanent fixture in 1906 as before that it was a temporary terminus. It was purchased and then put into a large property (original pictures attached in situ) and consist of many features. It was taken out of the property c2017 and warehouse stored. A great project as it could be used inside a property or outside. Further measurements are: On the main stairs as seen in picture, Height to each step 27 cm, Width of each step 30 cm, Width of each stair 127 cm, Height of rail 84 cm, Length of top rail 270 cm - On A1 it says the total height of stairs would be 245 cm. There are alot of other rails and fixings which are best seen. As indicated it has been stored for a few years and would benefit from a respray and painting to clients taste.
