Cleaned and waxed in our workshops and offered for sale in very good original condition. The upholstery is also in good order. Bearing original retailers label to the underside. F Danby's was a 19th century cabinet makers and upholsters run by Francis Danby in the Upper Headrow of Leeds, West Yorkshire. The company carried out work for the Council Chambers in Leeds having made the seats and fittings for the local council building.
