Pair of Royal Copenhagen porcelain figures, Denmark, polychrome-enamel decorated Amager man's and woman's market costumes, model numbers 12102 & 12103, mounted on titled square bases with printed factory marks. Designed by Carl Martin-Hansen (1877–1941) as part of his Danish National Costumes series of 47 figures produced between 1906 and 1925. Martin-Hansen was celebrated for naturalistic characterisation in busts and public monuments; this series was among his greatest successes.
