A striking brooch by Charles de Temple, one of the most innovative and influential jewellery designers of the 1960s and 70s. This magnificent abstract piece is crafted in 18k white and yellow gold, and punctuated by five round turquoise stones of varying size. Charles de Temple famously designed the ring in the James Bond film Goldfinger (1965), and was at the vanguard of the modernist jewellery movement in the mid- to late- twentieth century. With hallmarks from the London Assay office, and date marks indicating 1969. Signed CdeT Cut: Round cabochon turquoise. Dated: 1969. Measurements: 63.75mm at the widest and 34.6mm at the tallest.
