Original 1798 Newspaper – Nelson's Victory at Rosetta (Battle of the Nile) An original late 18th-century double-page spread from The Times, dated October 8th, 1798, reporting on Admiral Nelson's celebrated victory over the French fleet at the Battle of the Nile, near Rosetta (modern-day Rashid), Egypt. This decisive engagement marked a turning point in the Napoleonic Wars and is among the most renowned triumphs in British naval history. The newspaper sheet is mounted and glazed within a simulated walnut and mahogany frame, with a green mount and titled plaque reading: "Nelson's Victory at Rosetta – August 3rd 1798". The piece is attractively presented and ready to hang. Dimensions (framed): 77 cm x 66 cm (30 1/4 in x 26 in) Condition: The newspaper is in good condition for its age, showing expected toning and some minor edge wear. The frame has only slight wear and remains sturdy and presentable. A fine piece of historical interest, ideal for collectors of Nelsoniana, naval history, or Georgian-period artefacts.

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
