The top section with the superbly carved pediment of a central shell with swags to each side. The single door with the square astragal panes, opens to allow access to the glazed adjustable shelves. The lower section with the concave waist with a drawer, below are a pair of inverted break fronted doors with arches and cross-bandings. It stands on straight bracket feet.
