French, circa 1880 The chair and its upholstery are directly inspired by the bergère made by François-Honoré-Georges Jacob-Desmalter for Queen Hortense when she ruled over Holland alongside her husband Louis Napoleon, the French emperor's brother. Her son would later also become Emperor of the French as Napoleon III. Currently in unrestored condition. Please contact us for further information.
