The measure has straight sided body with low fillet and stands on a slightly flared and heavily stepped foot with a single curve handle. The inner base is marked with the makers mark along with a crowned X, and to the left of the handle are the four maker's hallmarks. Below the hallmarks is a clear IMPERIAL label. Ownership initials TCM are stamped in large clear letters. The single verification mark is for Somerset County. Provenance: Albert Bartram collection.
