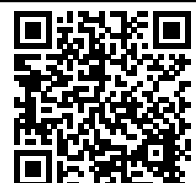
Description

This fresh and bright watercolour was painted by the well exhibited English artist Edith E Caswall. She is noted as a flower and landscape painter who travelled the continent painting whilst on her journey. This delightful work was done while visiting the Greek isle of Corfu, circa 1920 and captures from an unusually low perspective a view of rural cottages on a steep hillside. They have mellow stonework which is set in contrast against a vivid blue sky with a bright foreground showing a rocky landscape spread with exotic flowers and cacti. A most unusual competently captured work which is presented in a fine hand washed line mount with a swept gilt frame.
