Each diamond measures approximately 2mm in diameter, estimated total diamond weight is 0.42ct. They are of great presence when worn, very bright and fiery, no naked eye visible inclusion. Assessed diamond clarity is VS to SI and colour H-I. Inside the shank is the maker's mark SB&S Ld. It is also marked 18CT for 18ct gold and tests as such.
