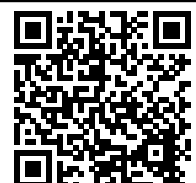
Designed in the early Aesthetic movement manner, the mahogany-veneered table enclosing three drawers inlaid with costly timbers including thuya and satinwood in a geometrical arabesque pattern, the splayed and flared legs with crossbanded capitals which is continued on the corners of the table, the overhanging moulded top supported with carved spandrels. Stamped "Collinson & Lock / London." English, Circa 1885. Currently in unrestored, original condition, please contact us for further information. Collinson & Lock of London. The firm of Collinson & Lock, successors to John Herring, an upholster and cabinet maker of Fleet Street, est 1782, was established in London in the third quarter of the 19th century, firstly at their old master's premises, and thereafter at the premises of the recently closed firm of Jackson and Graham. They quickly achieved both commercial success and a leading position in the field of design. In 1871 the firm issued an impressive illustrated catalogue of 'Artistic Furniture', with plates by J. Moyr Smith, assistant to Christopher Dresser, and in 1873 was trading from extensive newly built premises in St Bride Street. The firm continued to produce ...

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
