Description

This most impressive large scale 19th century aesthetic movement tray has been very skillfully made. It is of a large circular form with a raised edge which has been constructed with block sections of ash and turned on a lathe forming the pleasing curved and raised gallery which is finished with a band of ebony veneer on its top edge. The surface of the tray is decorated with a very complicated geometric design made from hundreds of delicately cut veneer sections which have been individually glued into place to form the stylised flower pattern in exotic timbers such as satinwood, tulipwood, and stained boxwood. This impressive work of art would be very pleasing to use as intended but also display well on a wall or as a centre piece on a table.
