He operated from 27 Piccadilly from 1829 to at least 1835, and potentially later, with evidence suggesting he was still listed at the address until 1880. Briggs was a prominent maker of various fine furniture and decorative items, including writing boxes, sewing boxes, and jewellery boxes.
