An enigmatic character, Carroll's style is very distinctive and immediately recognisable. His characters were often adorned with flowers or fruit and some of his generic studies were completed whilst he travelled throughout Europe and the UK, His work is highly sought after and is held in the UK Government Art Collection. This portrait is an absolutely delightful work and is a prime example of the artist's talent for creating expressive compos...
