Stamped MAW LONDON and with the military broad arrow or 'crows foot' ordnance mark has been used on British Army equipment since the 16th century. S. Maw & Son were London based makers of surgical equipment, throughout the 19th and 20th century. English, 19th century 9cm H, 31cm W, 2cm D.
