Boetzel - is a French artist recognized for his work as a wood-engraver and painter/draughtsman. Born in the Saar region of Alsace, his career spanned the mid 19th to early 20th century (c. 1830–1913), and his work has been appreciated for its technical precision and expressive qualities. While Boetzel was especially known for his detailed engravings, his ventures into painting and pastel drawings reveal a softer, more spontaneous side. This pastel drawing on canvas of a bull reflects his ability to capture both form and emotion with loose, delicate hues. This piece, like his other works, exhibits a naïve yet engaging style - a quality often admired in early 20th century pastoral art. This noted work attributed to him of a Bull in a Stable, dates from around 1900, underscoring his affinity for rendering subjects with a sense of lived in authenticity and warmth.
