He was also one of the Founders of the Hastings Bank about 1790 and so one could surmise that he was a pillar of the community of Important Standing. The 30 Hour Movement and finely engraved Brass Dial with Silvered Chapter Ring and Phoenix Spandrells has been Checked, Serviced & Tested to be in Good Working Order.
