This is a magnificent antique Arts and Crafts cedar wood and pewter casket, circa 1900 in date. The rectangular box features storks in flight with decoration and an inset round turquoise enamel plaque. Condition: In excellent condition, please see photos for confirmation. Dimensions in cm: Height 9 cm x Width 35 cm x Depth 17 cm. Dimensions in inches: Height 3 inches x Width 1 foot, 2 inches x Depth 7 inches. The Arts and Crafts movement was an international trend in the decorative and fine arts that developed earliest and most fully in the British Isles and subsequently spread across the British Empire and to the rest of Europe and America. Initiated in reaction against the perceived impoverishment of the decorative arts and the conditions in which they were produced, the movement flourished in Europe and North America between about 1880 and 1920. Some consider that it is the root of the Modern Style, a British expression of what later came to be called the Art Nouveau movement. Others consider that it is the incarnation of Art Nouveau in England. Others consider Art and Crafts to be in opposition to Art Nouveau. Arts and Crafts indeed criticized Art Nouveau ...

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
