The work is perhaps unique and is very close to an engraving produced by Theodoor Galle after an original design by Rubens believed to have here completed in circa 1650. The Museum number 1891,0414.1130 relates to the engraving held in the British museum. The official description of the work is "The Ascension; Jesus Christ with his arms aloft in top part, the Apostles and Virgin Mary onlooking from lower part"; after Theodor Galle who engra...
